



Political Signs

No signs may be placed in the public right-of-way. This includes median strips, highway entrance and exit ramps, traffic signs and posts, as well as utility poles.

On residential property:

1. Political and noncommercial signs shall be limited to the following types:

- Wall signs
- Window signs
- Ground signs not more than 6 feet above grade
- Signs shall not exceed 8 square feet in size

2. Political and noncommercial signs shall meet the following conditions:

- Shall be maintained in a clean, orderly, and sightly condition
- Shall not be illuminated
- Shall not be animated
- Shall not flash, blink, or fluctuate

On commercial property:

1. Political signs shall be limited to:

- Window signs
- Wall signs or posters which have been treated so as to be shielded from the elements (water, wind, sun, etc.)
- Window graphics consisting of paint or decals applied directly to glazing
